

<u>BTAS</u>

Bowls Tasmania Announced for the 20/21 season

Capitation -

Members currently pay \$52 (adults) and \$37 (juniors) in capitations to BNW which then goes to Bowls Tasmania, with part of that fee also going to Bowls Australia and World Bowls. The 2020/21 season will see the Bowls Tasmania fees reduced to \$37 per adult and \$26 per junior.

BNW Capitation – will remain the same as per last season - \$30 per member, no charge for juniors.

Directive - BOWLS PLAY IN THE NORTH WEST

FOLLOWING COVID 19 - 24/10/20

BTAS Return to Play – (please refer to BTAS document)

- All Clubs to follow Stage 3 Return to Play – this includes:
- 1. Covid Safe Plan in place.
- 2. Stay home if you feel sick.
- 3. Social Distancing must always be observed.
- 4. Practice Safe Hygiene.
- 5. Inside/Outdoor and Spectator Limit.
- Designated volunteer/staff member Covid Officer.
- 7. Hand Sanitiser available at entrances of the Club, beside each green and toilets.
- Disinfectant spray available beside mat/jack boxes – plan in place for all to be thoroughly cleaned before/after use. This also includes loaned bowls and score boards.

- Register of participants (for Pennant bowls link can be used, for Carnivals/Vets Days a list of all players must be kept).
 Clubs need to think of their business in two halves –
 - When operating Competitions (Pennant, Vets and Carnivals) - under the Return to Play rules and your local Conditions of Play.
 - Once the days play is completed your venue will continue to operate as a hospitality venue and under the hospitality regulations.

Clubs must remember that it is their own responsibility to ensure that they are complying with all Government rules and regulations during this time as each individual Club can be heavily fined by the Government should they not comply.

BNW Conditions of Play (Covid) -

- BNW Pennant, Vet Days and Carnivals -
- 1. Designate Leads to remove/move or place mats. The Jack can be rolled as per normal play.
- Designate Skips to remove/move jack (using foot, if possible) and mat (after use) or out of bounds bowls.
- 3. Designate 1 Second to do score board.
- 4. Do not handle other players Bowls (where possible). If a bowl goes into the ditch or out of bounds, remove and use hand hygiene.
- 5. All mats and jacks to be sanitized before and after each game.
- Communal Water Fountains will need to be sanitized between each person's use. Fresh disposable cups need to be available. If re-filling drink bottles, do not

allow the bottle to come into contact with the water nozzle.

BOWLS

- Raffles –
- 1. Designate 1-2 people only to do raffles (use contactless methods or throw away tickets), including Money Handling.
- Trade Tables –
- 1. Designated persons only to handle items and money.
- 2. Designated area with 'social distancing' room in place.
- 3. Inform customers to not touch items.
- Morning/Afternoon Tea (including serving of Meals) for BNW Pennant/Vets Day and Carnivals
- Designated person/s to make tea/coffee (no urn, tea/coffee, sugar, milk) for communal use. Mugs and cups can be used if they are sanitized through a dishwasher.
- 2. Designated area for 'used' items to be placed.
- 3. And/or use disposable items.
- 4. Food items pre-packaged or designated person to serve individual snacks. No communal platters, etc to be available.
- Food for Carnivals/Vets Days with meals

 staggered serving (as per club number in facility). All meals to be seated. BYO food can also be consumed in seated area.
- 6. Food for Carnivals canteen (buy and leave or as above).

- Alcohol during Competition –
- 1. Alcohol can only be consumed while seated. Alcohol should not be at the end of each rink. Alcohol must be consumed inside the licensed premises while seated or if there is a designated outdoor area with similar purpose where people can be seated.
- Spectators may consume alcohol while they are watching, provided that they are seated in a designated drinking area. Clubs may set up a designated 'wet' area for spectators to sit while watching. Players are not permitted to sit in this area while they are competing.

Some other added frequently questions below -

Water Fountains – Public drinking water supplies are safe to drink, however the surfaces around the fountain including the spout, button/leaver and nozzle could pose a risk for the transmission of Covid 19 and other germs. Do not place your mouth on the spout of the fountain or allow your water bottle too. Test the water flow and let the water flow for 10 seconds to allow for fresh, clean water to come through prior to drinking. If the fountain requires you to push a button or lever, clean the surface before and after, or use your elbow. Clean your hands afterwards with an alcohol-based rub or wash them with soap and water.
